Marstel-Day is a member of a joint venture (JV) with LRS Federal to provide environmental and historical services to the Department of Veteran Affairs, Office of Construction and Facilities Management. Specific services include NEPA documentation; Phase I and Phase II environmental site assessments (ESAs); wetland delineations and Section 401/404 consultation and coordination; Migratory Bird Treaty Act and Endangered Species Act compliance; groundwater feasibility studies, water resources analysis, and well drilling; subsurface investigations; cultural resources documentation including Historic American Buildings Survey, Historic American Engineering Record, and Historic American Landscape Survey (HABS/HAER/HALS); National Register of Historic Places determinations of eligibility and nominations; cultural and archaeological surveys; and consultation support.
